# - Why are we processing your personal data?

Your personal data are collected to:

- Manage all aspects related to your application for the university degree.
- Additionally, if you have consented to doing so, the ETSIINF uses these data for future communications, such as delivery of diplomas, satisfaction and job placement studies for degreeholders, and alumni monitoring.

## - How long will we store your data?

Your data will be stored for the period set forth in administrative and archive procedural regulations.

- What is the legal basis for processing your data? The legal basis for processing your data is contained in art. 6.1.b; 6.1.c) and 6.1.a) of EU Regulation 2016/679) and bears on the fact that doing so is necessary to carry out your application for the issue of the degree, to comply with a legal obligation stemming from Royal Decree 1393/2007 for job-placement surveys, to verify study plans, and the interested party's consent in the event of other kinds of communications.
- Do you have the obligation to provide these personal data, and what are the consequences of not doing so?
  - To process your application for the university degree, it is necessary that you provide us with your personal data. Otherwise, we cannot issue the degree.
  - o In terms of future communications, there is no obligation to provide the data. The consequence is that we will not be able to communicate with you for this purpose.
- With which recipients will your data be shared? Your data will not be shared with third parties unless legal obligation mandates doing so.

## - What are your rights in relation to the data you have provided?

- You have the rights to access, rectify, delete, oppose, and limit, depending on the specific characteristics of the data processing and the moment when you wish to exercise said rights.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

The student must send through email or the internal incidents system the following documentation::

- A form to apply for the degree.
- Payment Form (copies for Student, the Centre, and the University)
- -ID Document (DNI) or Passport
- Receipt from the Library that no books are on loan and they have, already received your TFG.

The secretary's office will then provide the corresponding payment form and the student must provide proof of payment. At that moment, we will start the processing of your university degree. We will notify you (via the e-mail address specified in the application form) when it is available, approximately two years from now.

In case the student needs a "proof" of having applied for the degree, the following options are available:

- Receive a stamped degree application letter of payment from the Student's secretary.
- To request a free proof of application for the degree via e-mail. It will be available digitally signed within 10 working days.
- Request a free Substitute Certificate of the Degree, two or three months after the end of the application process, by e-mail directly to the UPM Archive and Degrees Service at the following address
